BELOW ARE SUMMARIZED THE RULES TO FOLLOW

HOUSEHOLD WASTE

yellow bags

YES: non-recoverable waste; rags and small pieces of cloth, dirty or greased paper; waxed, laminated, carbon and carbonless copy paper; sauce and toothpaste tubes; gauzes, plasters and only syringes with protected needles; nappies; used tissues; cotton buds; animal bedding; cigarettes; vacuum bags; compact cassettes and videotapes; toys, buttons; chimney ash; polystyrene used for packaging, plastic cutlery, mollusc shells, small pieces of pottery and earthenware, waste made of different materials.

NO: differentiated parts; bulky waste; liquid waste; dangerous waste (sprays, batteries, neon lights, paint, etc.); barbed objects (which can lacerate the bags or provoke injuries to the operators)

ORGANIC WASTE

YES: cooked and raw food scraps and leftovers; eggshells; fruit and vegetable scraps; fish bones, bones; coffee grounds, tea bags; small animal guts; cheese rind; bread; peels, pods; vegetables; fruit pits, food gone bad, cut flowers and houseplants.

NO: liquid waste; garden trimmings; plastic, polystyrene, waxed paper, Tetra Pack (milk, wine and fruit juice cartons, etc.); cans; little tubes; sprays; bowls; animal litter; rags, nappies; medicines, gauzes and plasters.

PAPER/CARDBOARD/TETRA PACK

white bin

YES: paper and cardboard; newspapers, magazines, notebooks, sheets; notes; folders; boxes; cardboard boxes; die cut cardboard boxes; books; tetra pack (milk, wine and fruit juice cartons, etc.)

NO: waxed, laminated, and carbonless copy paper; plastic detergent bottles; dirty paper, receipts.

PLASTIC (packages)

blue bags

YES: plastic canister for liquids made of PET (bottles of water or beverages, etc.), PE (detergents and cosmetics bottles, etc.), PVC (bottles of water, etc.); stiff/flexible food packages (ex. cold cuts, cheese, fresh pasta, fruit, vegetables); food bags; egg boxes, ice-cream pints and bowls, yogurt and dessert container; fruit and vegetable nets; film and foils; pots and pot saucers; plastic glasses and plates.

NO: plastic objects (toys, fruit crates, etc.); audio cassettes and videotapes; any non-plastic product, durable plastic goods (white goods, furniture); CD custodies, music cassettes and videotapes; irrigation pipes; clothes hangers; glue, paint and solvent containers; bags, backpacks, ashtrays and pencil holders ; folders; car accessories and components.

GLASS/ALUMINIUM/TINPLATE

blue bin

YES: glass waste (bottles, jars, glasses) of any colour and without stoppers; aluminium waste (cans, tins, bowls and "AL" marked sheets, etc.); tin cans (tuna; peeled tomatoes, etc.).

NO: plastic stoppers, lids and other metallic parts; ceramic objects (plates, cups, etc.); plastic objects (bags, etc.); mirrors and light bulbs; glass plate; iron objects; packages coated with paper or synthetic substances (frozen food and packaged soup bags).
